PORT AND DOCK COMMITTEE

1943 - 1944 saw a decline in the number of people that we were called upon to assist. It has become increasingly difficult for Jewish people to leave Nazi Europe and fewer passenger boats have arrived at this port. This committee has met fifteen steamers and assisted thirty-two refugees. We furnished transportation for them, attended to their baggage and railroad tickets, entrained them and found hotel rooms when necessary.

Lack of work usually means lack of interest but my committee members have stood by faithfully and performed their tasks well. I want to take this opportunity to thank them for their loyalty.
